 exposure and Dry heat exposure with use of machine dryer. Know minimum
 number of days to complete drying process of Cocoons for a batch.
- Practical work for sorting of defective Cocoons which are not suitable for reeling.
- Know Storage procedure of sorted dried Cocoons at controlled temperature and humidity room safely. Save Cocoon stocks from fungus attacks.
