NOTIFICATION

Subject: Submission of Eligibility Documents of all admitted Pharmacy students including Management Quota in AY 2024-25

Principals/Principals-in-Charge/Institutional Heads of the Self-Financed Pharmacy Institutions that have secured affiliation/renewal of affiliation from this Council in AY 2024-25, are requested to submit their admitted students' list and their admission eligibility documents (Photocopy of HS Marksheet, Admit Card of Qualifying Examination, Aadhar Card etc.) to the Council office at Newtown, Rajarhat positively by **8th May, 2025**.

Student list and eligibility documents have to be submitted in following manners.

- Students' names in the list should be in alphabetical order.
- Admission eligibility documents of each student should be stappled as a bunch. Each bunch should carry all eligibility documents. No subsequent submission of loose documents shall be allowed.
- Such bunches should be arranged in the same alphabetical order of the students' list.
- All above documents have to be placed inside a four-fold file properly labelled with Name, Code & District of the Institution.
- Students' list should be placed on the top of the eligibility documents inside the four-fold file.

It is the responsibility of the respective Institutes to ensure that each of their admitted students is fulfilling the eligibility criteria as prescribed by the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), failing which their candidature will be cancelled and registration will not be allowed. Registration certificate will be issued only to the eligible (validated, verified okay & registered) students of the respective Institutions. Admission eligibility criteria & list of recognised boards of the Council are enclosed herewith.

Principals/Principals-in-charge/Institutional Heads are requested to take note of the above and do the needful.

Annexure I

Essential Student Eligibility Criteria for Pharmacy Registration in 2024-25

- Candidate must be an **Indian Citizen**
- Passed Higher Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent examination in General Stream Course with **Physics, Chemistry & Biology or Mathematics**.
- Candidates passed Higher Secondary (10+2) examination or equivalent examinations in **Vocational Stream Courses are not eligible for admission** in Diploma in Pharmacy course, as per prescribed admission eligibility criteria of Pharmacy Council of India.
- A student passed from **Open School Education System** of the **Central Government/ State Government Institutions** with Science stream (**Physics, Chemistry & Biology or Mathematics**) for a 2 years course, equivalent to HS, are eligible as per PCI in its 97th Central Council meeting held in June 2015.
- Candidate shall complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December of the year for admission to the Pharmacy Course, i.e. the **candidate should not be born after 31.12.2007**. There is upper no age limit

Note:

1. In case of any minor discrepancy in the name of the candidate (verified within the eligibility documents), the same must be either corrected from the relevant department or authorized by the submission of an affidavit from First-Class Judicial Magistrate or First-Class Executive Magistrate from the district court where the candidate belongs.
